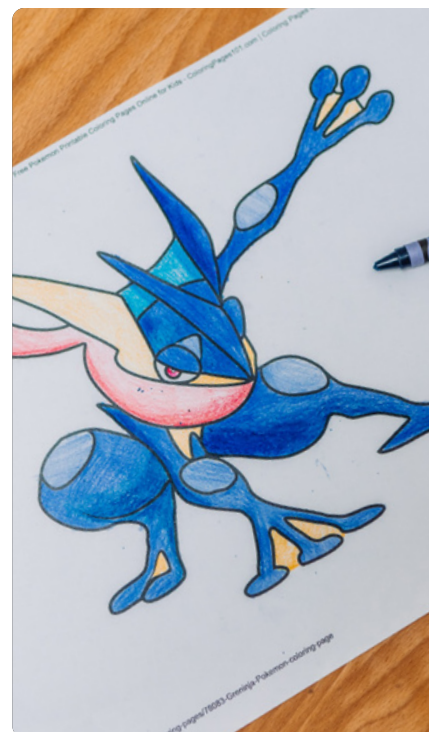

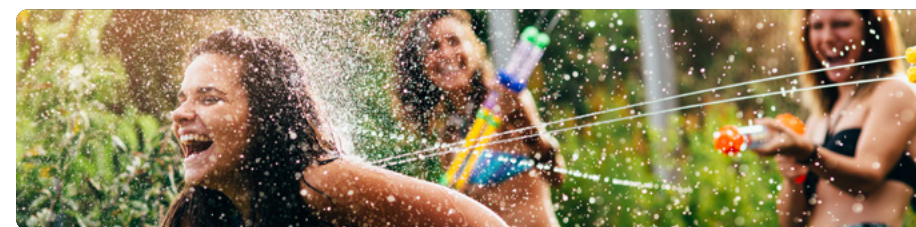

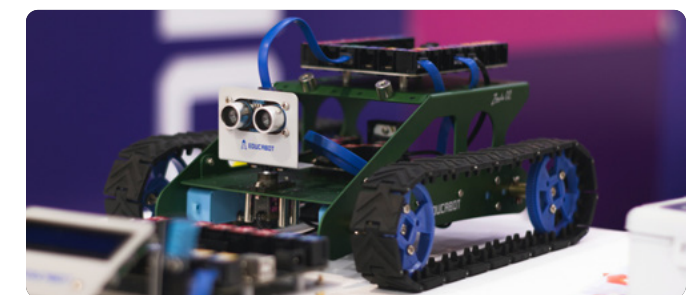

She transforms this surface embroidery technique into textile design and vinyl imagery, playing with geometric shapes and repeating patterns. Taken together, these works build on Vanessa's continued exploration of what it means to live in an Indigenous, gendered body with a neurodiverse mind.
