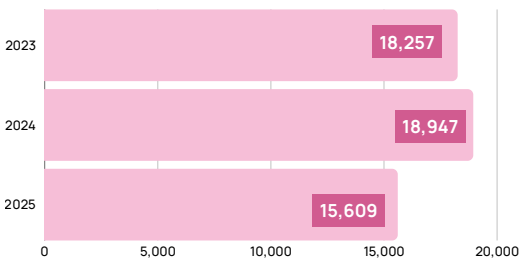

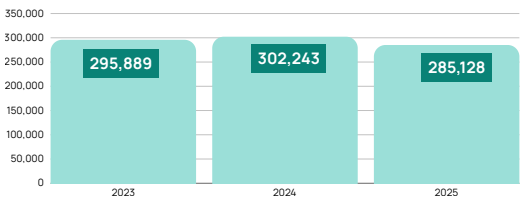


Program Attendance
